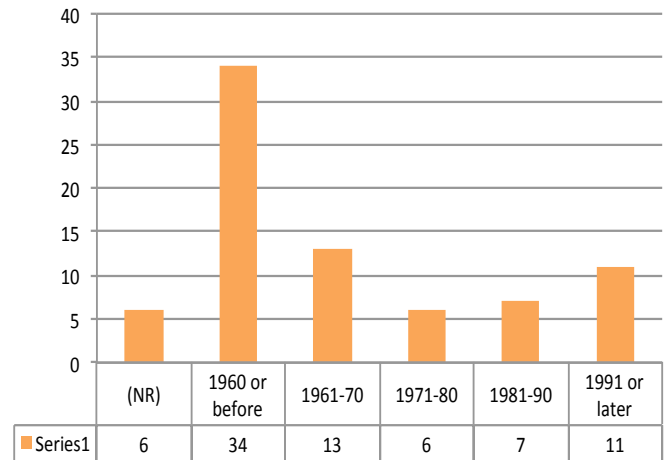

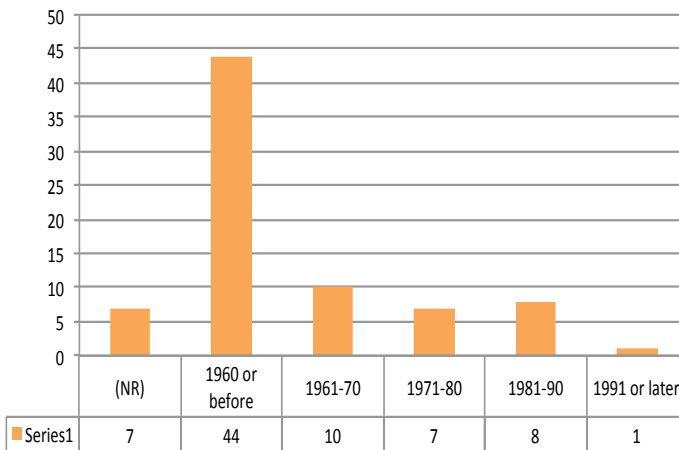
Question 1: Have you participated in a CitizenDetroit event before? (n=52)



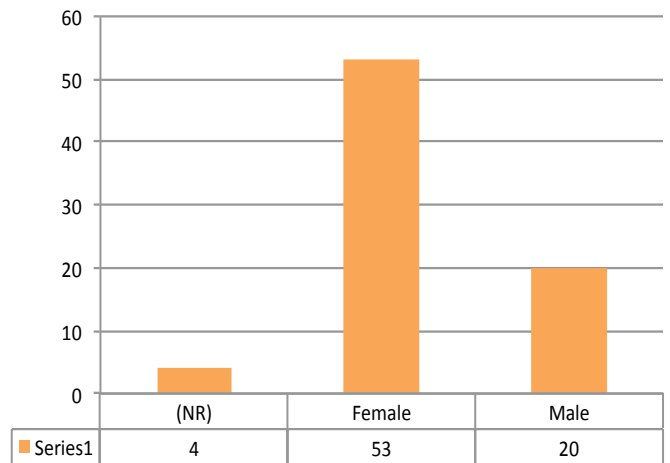
Question 2: I have lived in Detroit since... (n=52)



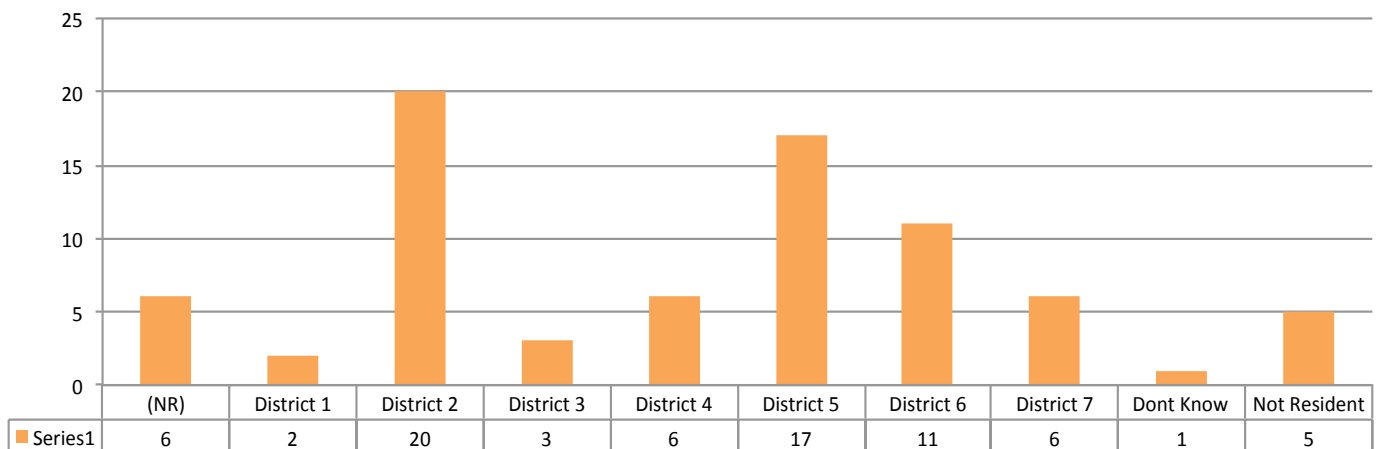
Question 3: I was born in... (n=53)



Question 4: My gender is... (n=53)

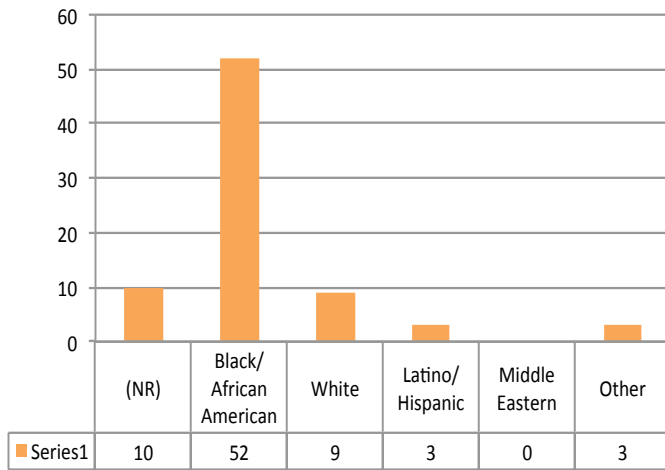


Question 5: I live in... (n=52)

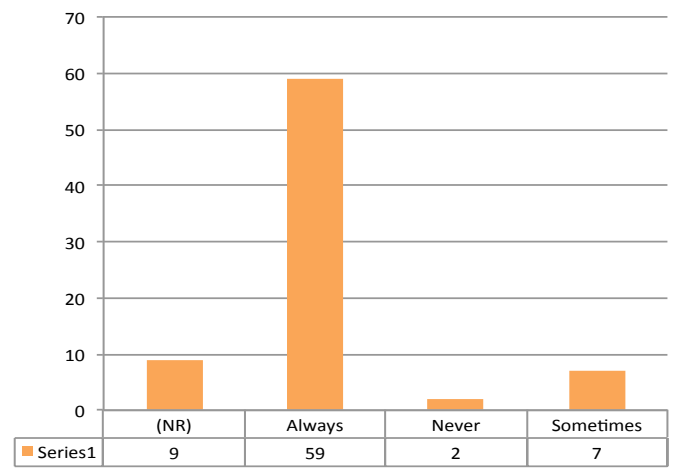

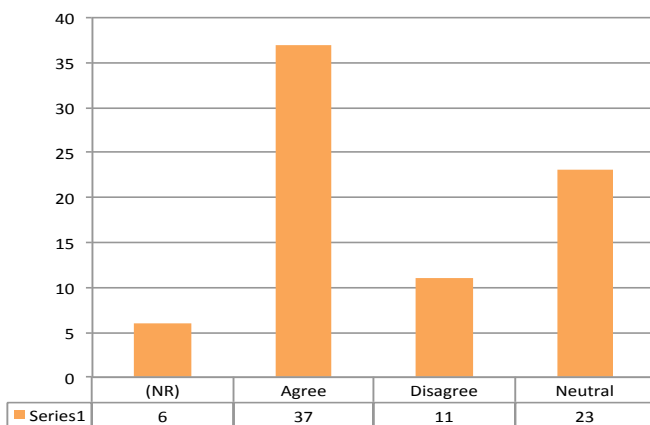
Question 6: I consider myself... (n=54)



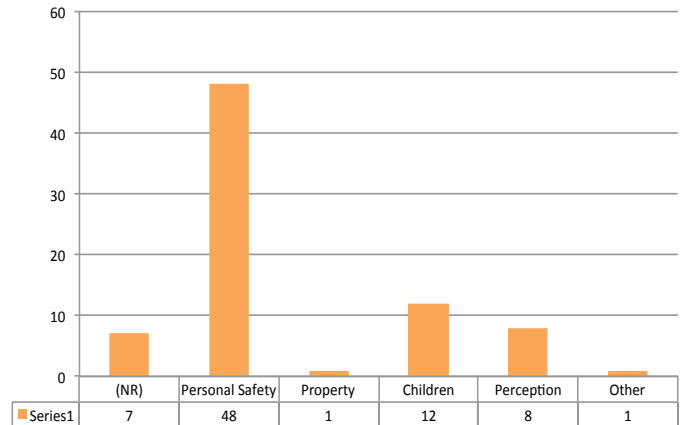
Question 7: Do you vote in primaries? (n=56)



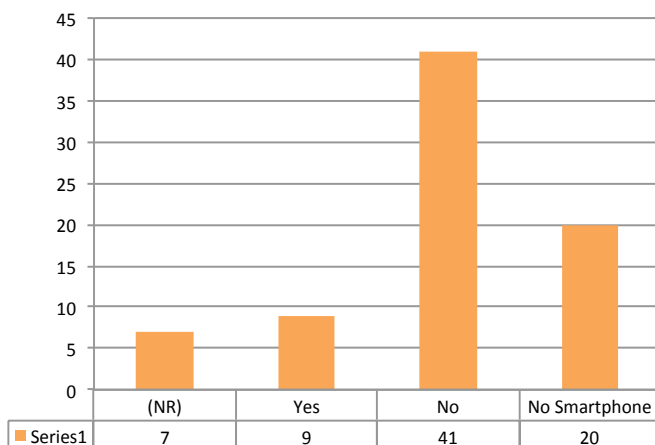
Question 8: The new streetlights make me feel safer. (n=54)



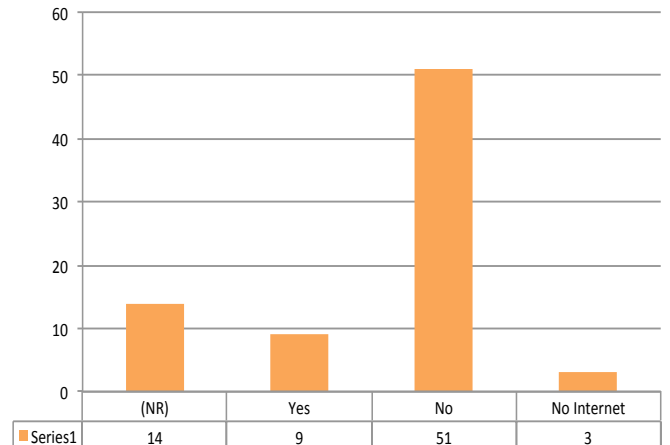
Question 9: Which aspect of safety is most important to you? (n=54)



Question 11: Have you used the DPDConnect app? (n=55)

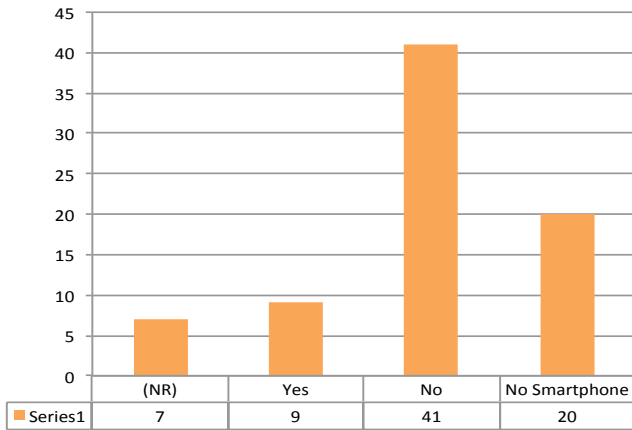


Question 12: Have you visited the Detroit Police Department's Facebook page? (n=55)

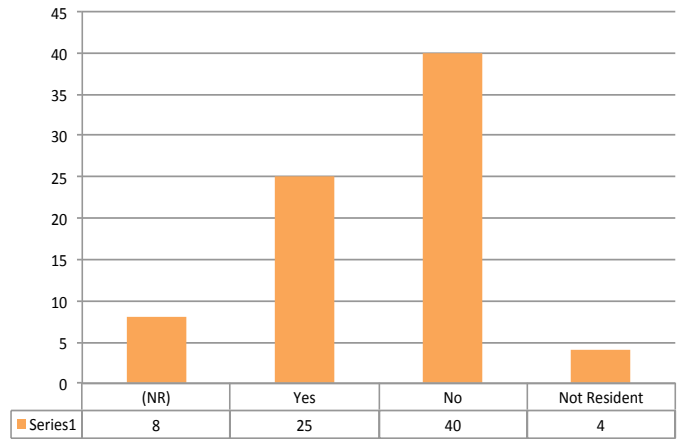

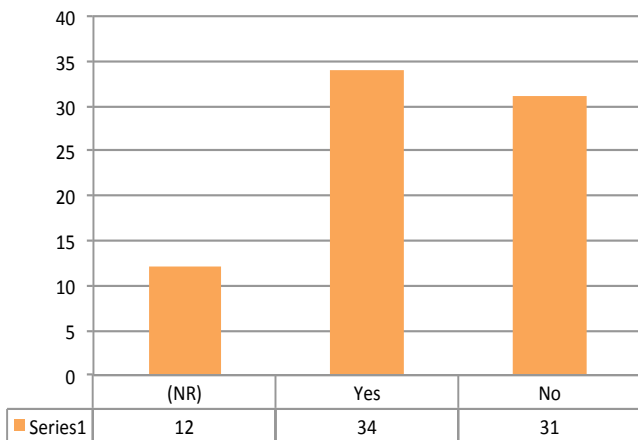
Question 13: Have you heard of the Neighborhood Police Officer program? (n=52)



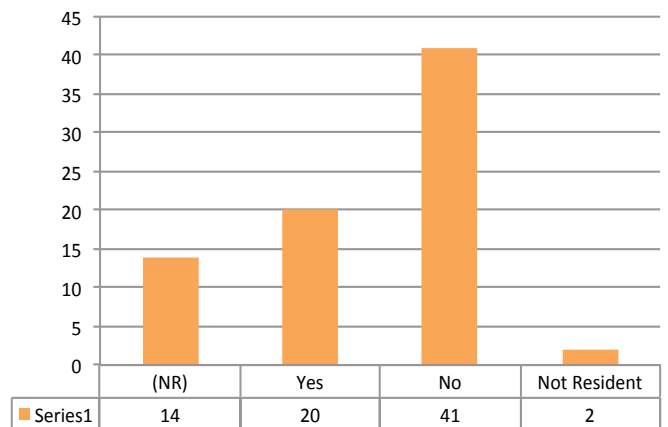
Question 14: Have you met your Neighborhood Police Officer(s)? (n=56)



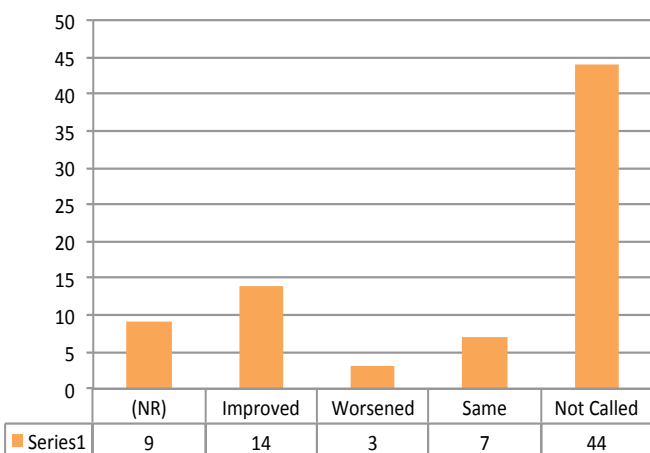
Question 15: Have you heard of Police community relations meetings? (n=56)



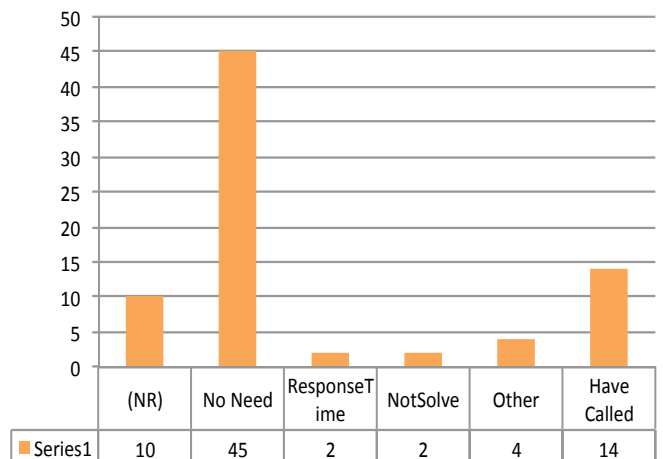
Question 16: Do you attend Police-community relations meetings? (n=56)



Question 17: Over the last 12 months, when I have called 911, response times have... (n=53)

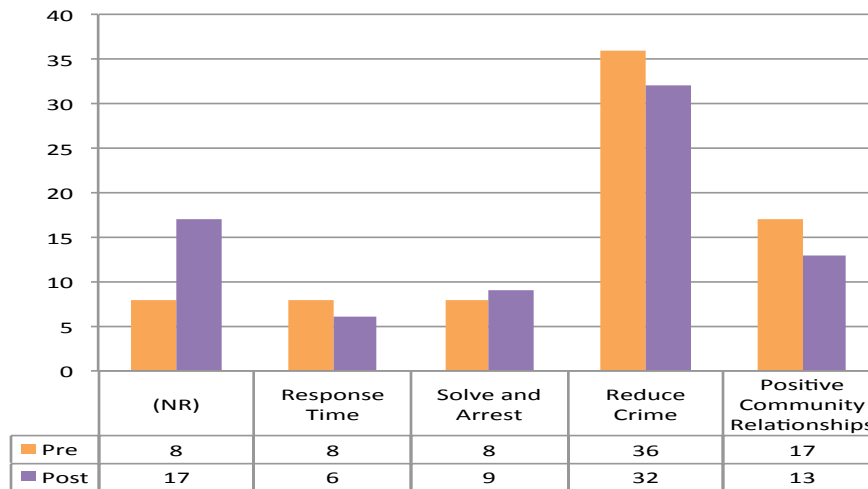


Question 18: Over the last 12 months, when I have called 911, response times have... (n=52)

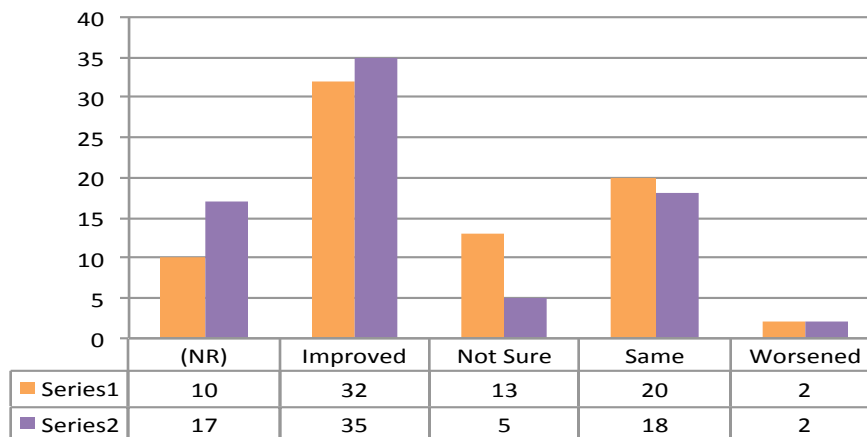

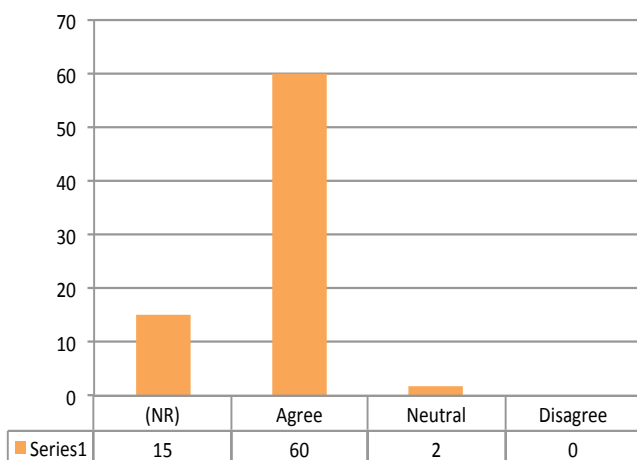
Question 10: Which policing outcome is most important to you? (n1=54, n2=42)



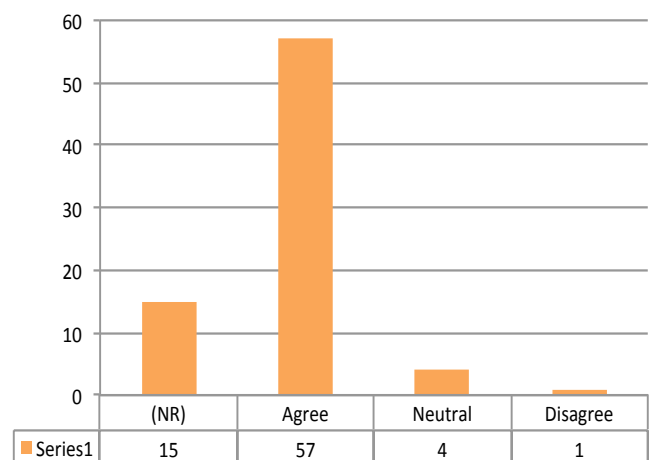
Question 19: Since Mayor Duggan took office, my view of the Detroit Police Department has... (n1=51, n2=36)
